

BOY SCOUT TROOP 995

Patrol Advisor, Adult Leader

Objectives:

Help Scouts have fun while making constructive use of their time. Generally act as a "Big Brother" and "Wise Counselor" for one or more Scout Patrols.

Specific Duties:

1. Meet with patrol members during patrol meetings, attend Patrol Leaders Councils, provide guidance and coaching to Patrol Leaders, Asst. Patrol Leaders, Patrol Quartermasters, and Patrol Scribes during Patrol Meetings, Troop Meetings, and other Troop activities, as appropriate.
2. Ensure that Patrol Leaders are following Patrol Meeting Guidelines.
3. Attend Adult Leader meetings to share information about patrol needs, to receive information that will be helpful to patrol members, to help influence Troop 995 program decisions, and to participate in establishing Troop policy.
4. Go on camping trips and other outings with their patrol.
5. Encourage Scouts to work on their rank advancement, assist them in passing advancement requirements and completing paperwork needed to get awards.

All positions below the rank of Scoutmaster are appointed positions. Appointments are determined by the Scoutmaster, in consultation with the Committee Chairman & are 'at will' positions. Adults in the above position must be registered as an "Adult Leader" & need to complete "New Leader Essentials".
